Earnest brew works "home of the earnest pour"

1. Orion the Hunter – Black Imperial Wheat. As you look toward the early evening eastern sky you will notice the constellation, Orion the Hunter. The stars shine bright, Orion pours black, like the winter sky, with subtle roast notes due to the high wheat content.

2. Blueberry Maple Crunchy Hippie – Inspired by a hearty stack of blueberry pancakes and is brewed with oats, wheat and granola nuggets. Sweet and tart notes of blueberry pair perfectly with the caramel nutty flavors of maple syrup to make this Crunchy Hippie variant a brunchworthy treat!

3. Easy – Lager. Golden yellow color, light body and tastes awesome! Easy lager is special, not just another lager, it a craft lager. The addition of rice reduces the maltiness for a cleaner flavor. Motueka Hops have a natural lively lemon and lime characteristics that are noticeable with a clean ever so subtle note of citrus crispness.

4. Hello Beer – Hibiscus Beer. Brewed with hibiscus flower, sweet orange peel and a touch of coriander. There is subtle hibiscus flowers on the nose, pours a nice pinkish color, with a white head, low bitterness and a pleasant clean finish.

- 6. New Sincerity West Coast IPA. West Coast IPAs focus on hops. Citrus and floral hops nose, medium body with a most pleasant taste. Sip after sip, New Sincerity delivers.

7. Killerney-Irish Red Cream Ale – This is the beer that made the village of Killerney famous. Red in color, strong body and low on hops.

8. Raspberry Cream Summer Wheat. This American-style wheat beer is fermented with raspberry juice to give it plenty of fruit flavor. Oats add to the creamy mouthfeel, making this beer as enjoyable as a bright summer day.

Honeybuzz - Double IPA with honey. Honey forward, comes off as not as hoppy as other DIPA's due
to the large amount of locally sourced honey in this beer. Don't be fooled by the smoothness of this

10. Peanut Butter Worker's Porter-This porter was designed for smooth Peanut Butter enjoyment. A clean fermenting yeast allows the slight roast from the malt to be detected.

11. O'Byrne's Dry Irish Stout on NITRO - A traditional Irish dry stout. These stouts finish dry, as opposed to a sweet stout or a milk stout. This is one dark beer that is not heavy and at an Irish 4%, you will be able to enjoy a pint or three.

12. AM/PM on NITRO – Blonde Coffee Ale. Custom, light roasted coffee from Actual Coffee was used in this blonde ale. Pouring via NITRO adds a smoothness that has to be experienced. Don't be fooled by the color, there is plenty of coffee in this beer. Enjoy it in the AM or PM.

13. Crunchy Hippie – Granola Brown Ale. This beer was developed name first, what is a Crunchy Hippie beer? After some thought, the idea of liquid granola was used to come up with the recipe. Brewed with actual granola, plus oats, wheat and cherries.

15. LEAP BEER 2024-Strawberry Lemon Sour Ale. Not every year is a Leap Year, and not every beer is an earnest beer. The flavors of Strawberries and Lemons combine to be a taste pleaser. Late-hopped with HBC 522, Huell Melon and Lemondrop hops. Brewed once every four years, this beer definitely has FOMO, don't miss out. Available in 16 oz cans to go. Limit one case.

IBU 31 SRM 6.4 ABV 7.0% Price Tier 2

16. Under Pressure-Hazy Pale Ale. This beer is the little brother to our favorite hazy IPA, Beer Pressure. Double dry-hopped and whirlpooled with loads of Amarillo, Citra, and Mosaic hops, Under Pressure showcases notes of grapefruit, mango, and berries. Low bitterness and a sweeter finish enhances the "juicy" mouthfeel of each sip.

IBU 23 SRM 4 ABV 5.4% Price Tier 1

17. Blueberry Queen – The Queen has been reborn. BQ started out as a grape/grain hybrid beer with blueberries, and now more of a beer with Pilsen malt and Flaked Rice. Natural Blueberry flavor was added and most notable is ABV was reduced from 10% to a more sessionable 5.8%. Lower alcohol now means you can enjoy the queen by the pint.

IBU 13 SRM 3 ABV 5.6% Price Tier 1

18. **LONDON CALLING** – A Clash of US and British IPA Styles. Brewed with malt, hops and yeast from each great IPA nation. The hop nose is all American Simcoe and the alcohol was kept low, as the British prefer.
