**Ask the barkeep about our newest beers!**

- 1. Earnest American Festbier-** Modeled after German Festbier, served in Munich during Oktoberfest. The earnest version is brewed lighter, with less biscuit/cracker/toasted malt tasting notes to better match the American Lager style. To be poured the German American Fest.  
IBU 22      SRM 4      ABV 5.5%      Price Tier 1
- 2. Hoppy Camper – Hazy Pale Ale.** A juicy blend of Citra, Mosaic, and El Dorado hops will take you on an adventure. Hiking in the woods, an evening around a fire, or kicking it with your friends are all better with a Hoppy Camper.  
IBU 26      SRM 4      ABV 5.2%      Price Tier 1
- 3. Easy – Lager.** Golden yellow color, light body and tastes awesome! Easy lager is special, not just another lager, it a craft lager. Motueka Hops have a natural lively lemon and lime characteristics that are noticeable with a clean ever so subtle note of citrus crispness.

- 4. Worker's Porter-**This porter was designed for smooth enjoyment. A clean fermenting yeast allows the slight roast from the malt to be detected.

- 5. Beer Pressure - Juicy IPA.** New England style IPA is the hottest beer style and EBW was pressured to brew one. Beer Pressure pours cloudy, with a smooth, creamy mouthfeel via the oats added to the mash. Our mission statement is to brew beers for our community's enjoyment, we hope you enjoy.  
IBU 48      SRM 4      ABV 6.8%      Price Tier 1      Available in 4-packs to go
- 6. New Sincerity – West Coast IPA.** West Coast IPAs focus on hops. Citrus and floral hops nose, medium body with a most pleasant taste. Sip after sip, New Sincerity delivers.  
IBU 61      SRM 9      ABV 6.9%      Price Tier 1      Available in 6-packs to go
- 7. Gales of November – Blackberry Sour.** Brewed with Mosaic and Huell Melon hops. On November 10, 1975, the Edmund Fitzgerald sank in Lake Superior during a hurricane force storm. This beer is a tribute to the 29 men that perished when the gales of November came slashin'.  
IBU 30      SRM 20      ABV 7.5%      Price Tier 2
- 8. Midnight Train Goin' Anywhere – Hazy DIPA.** Just a city beer, brewed and enjoyed on S. Detroit. Pours with a full array of Mosaic, Galaxy and El Dorado hop aroma and flavor. As you embark on your journey, let it linger in your mouth, to get the full hop effect.  
IBU 70      SRM 4      ABV 8.3%      Price Tier 2
- 9. Honeybuzz – Double IPA with honey.** Honey forward, comes off as not as hoppy as other DIPA's due to the large amount of locally sourced honey in this beer. Don't be fooled by the smoothness of this DIPA, it will get you buzzing.  
IBU 88      SRM 10      ABV 9.1%      Price Tier 2      Available in 4-packs to go
- 10. Rhymes with Orange – Orange and Vanilla Sour/Tart beer.** Not as sour as most sours, this sour has more of a note of vanilla that pushes it further in the direction of a sweet creamsicle.  
IBU 30      SRM 7      ABV 7.2%      Price Tier 2
- 11. Peanut Butter Crunchy Hippie – Granola Brown Ale.** This beer was developed name first, what is a Crunchy Hippie beer? After some thought, the idea of liquid granola was used to come up with the recipe. Brewed with oats, wheat, brown sugar, honey, sunflower/chia/hemp seeds, raisins, and cherries.  
IBU 40      SRM 21      ABV 6.2%      Price Tier 1

12. **Crunchy Hippie – Granola Brown Ale.** This beer was developed name first, what is a Crunchy Hippie beer? After some thought, the idea of liquid granola was used to come up with the recipe. Brewed with actual granola, plus oats, wheat and cherries.  
IBU 40      SRM 21      ABV 6.2      Price Tier 1
13. **Big Oatis – Double Oatmeal Stout.** Double the normal amount of oats give this beer an incredible smoothness. Make Big Oatis your liquid wing man, he will not let you down.  
IBU 50      SRM 40      ABV 7.3%      Price Tier 1
14. **O Tannenbaum-Spruce Tip Ale.** Utilizes Fresh spruce tips in the boil as the replacement for some of the hops, normally present for bitterness. The aroma is full of pleasant, not distracting spruce notes, followed by a unique perfectly balanced spruce flavor component. This is the Christmas ale you have been waiting for.  
IBU 32      SRM 6      ABV 6.8%      Price Tier 2
15. **Holiday Toast – English Holiday Ale with Cinnamon.** This beer is a celebration of the breadly malt character of Maris Otter Malt, English Fuggle hops, and touch of cinnamon. Raise your glass and toast to your health.  
IBU 25      SRM 12      ABV 5.3%      Price Tier 1
16. **The Spice is Right – blonde spiced winter ale.** Some winter beers have way too much spice, some have too little spice. EBW brewed The Spice is Right, as you guessed it, has just the right amount of spice. Pours nice and blonde with a spice mix of cinnamon, ginger and clove.  
IBU 32      SRM 4      ABV 6.4%      Price Tier 1
17. **Holiday Spicewood – American Barleywine style ale** brewed with copious amounts of spices, coriander, allspice, nutmeg and crystalized ginger. Just for an extra kick, pounds, upon pounds of cinnamon sticks and toasted oak chips were added. The nose is full of cinnamon, drinks smooth, with a hint of orange and finishes with a slight oakness.  
IBU 62      SRM 26      ABV 9.2%      Price Tier 2
18. **Before the Sun - Imperial Coffee Stout.** Balanced coffee nose, rich body and slight chocolate on the backend. There are two kinds of people that are up before the sun rises: hard-working folks, trying to get a jump on the day and people that are still up, operating in the shadows. This one is brewed with a custom roasted Ethiopian coffee from Flying Rhino Coffee in Toledo.
