**Ask the barkeep about Crunchy Hippy Month!**

- 1. Cold Break - Cold Pale Ale.** A cold lager strain of yeast was utilized over the warmer fermenting ale yeast. Plus the addition of rice to lighten the body lead to a low/soft bitterness that allows for a “showcase of hop flavor”, without the bitterness. Hops: Azacca, Nectaron, and Rakau.  
IBU 36      SRM 4      ABV 5.3%      Price Tier 1
- 2. Hoppy Camper – Hazy Pale Ale.** A juicy blend of Citra, Mosaic, and El Dorado hops will take you on an adventure. Hiking in the woods, an evening around a fire, or kicking it with your friends are all better with a Hoppy Camper.

- 3. Easy – Lager.** Golden yellow color, light body and tastes awesome! Easy lager is special, not just another lager, it a craft lager. Motueka Hops have a natural lively lemon and lime characteristics that are noticeable with a clean ever so subtle note of citrus crispness.

- 4. Kolsch Lager -** a light, crisp German cold-conditioned lager with a smooth, clean finish. It has a pale golden color, subtle fruitiness, and a delicate balance of mild hop bitterness and soft malt sweetness.

- 5. Beer Pressure - Juicy IPA.** New England style IPA is the hottest beer style and EBW was pressured to brew one. Beer Pressure pours cloudy, with a smooth, creamy mouthfeel via the oats added to the mash. Our mission statement is to brew beers for our community’s enjoyment, we hope you enjoy.

- 6. New Sincerity – West Coast IPA.** West Coast IPAs focus on hops. Citrus and floral hops nose, medium body with a most pleasant taste. Sip after sip, New Sincerity delivers.

- 7. LONDON CALLING –** A Clash of US and British IPA Styles. Brewed with malt, hops and yeast from each great IPA nation. The hop nose is all American Simcoe and the alcohol was kept low, as the British prefer.

- 8. the object –** Double New England IPA. The object represents the force & presence of beer. With a blend of Mosaic, Simcoe and Citra hops, this is a juicy Double New England you don’t want to miss.

- 9. Honeybuzz –** Double IPA with honey. Honey forward, comes off as not as hoppy as other DIPA’s due to the large amount of locally sourced honey in this beer. Don’t be fooled by the smoothness of this DIPA, it will get you buzzing.

- 10. Infinite Loop DIPA.** This hazy double IPA features three flowable hop extracts made from Citra, Mosaic, and Sabro hops. This extract is produced through supercritical extraction of hop pellets with carbon dioxide and is designed to amplify hop aromatics and increase batch yield. Welcome to the future of IPA.

- 11. Barrel Aged Café Earnuccino –** Coffee stout with chocolate. Aged in a Buffalo Trace Bourbon Barrel. Skillfully blended with lactose (milk sugar) and vanilla to balance the roast of the coffee beans.

12. **Crunchy Hippy – Granola Brown Ale.** This beer was developed name first, what is a Crunchy Hippy beer? After some thought, the idea of liquid granola was used to come up with the recipe. Brewed with actual granola, plus oats, wheat and cherries.

13. **Elvis Crunchy Hippy – Granola Brown Ale.** Brewed with actual granola, plus oats, wheat and cherries, this variation also hints at the King’s favorite classic with flavors of peanut butter and banana. The only thing missing is the bacon.

14. **Cherry on Wayward Pom – Cherry Pomegranate Sour/Tart beer.** Pours the most beautiful shade of red, with a nose of cherry and pomegranates. Backed up with a puckering flavor, that encourages you to tip your glass again and again. Cherry on.

15. **Wake & Bake Crunchy Hippy – Coffee and Maple Syrup Granola Brown Ale.** The roast of the coffee goes together with the sweet flavor of maple syrup. Crunchy Hippy is an earnest fan favorite.

16. **Hello Beer - Hibiscus beer.** Brewed with hibiscus flowers, sweet orange peel and a touch of coriander. There is subtle hibiscus flowers on the nose, pours a nice pinkish color, with a white head, low bitterness and a pleasant clean finish.  
 IBU 24      SRM 4      ABV 5.7%      Price Tier 1
17. **Between the Limes - Tart Lime IPA.** Featuring Citra, Mosaic and Motueka hops. The tartness will hit you a bit harder, as you sip it will mellow until your glass is empty. Read between the limes, this is a great beer.  
 IBU 40      SRM 4      ABV 7.2%      Price Tier 2
18. **Earnest Shandy - Lemon.** Lemon shandy plus a hint of Strawberry add up to refreshment. Opens with a wonderful lemon aroma, followed by the most pleasant lemon flavor. The addition of strawberry balances out the bitterness of the lemon. Leaving a low 4.5% perfect for all day enjoyment.
