1. **Cold Break - Cold Pale Ale.** A cold lager strain of yeast was utilized over the warmer fermenting ale yeast. Plus the addition of rice to lighten the body lead to a low/soft bitterness that allows for a “showcase of hop flavor”, without the bitterness. Hops: Azacca, Nectarone, and Rakau.
IBU 36 SRM 4 ABV 5.3% Price Tier 1\
2. **Hoppy Camper – Hazy Pale Ale.** A juicy blend of Citra, Mosaic, and El Dorado hops will take your palate on an adventure. Hiking in the woods, an evening around a fire, or kicking it with your friends are all better with a Hoppy Camper.

3. **Easy – Lager.** Golden yellow color, light body and tastes awesome. This lager was created to be something special, not just another lager, it is a craft lager. Motueka Hops have a natural lively lemon and lime characteristics that are noticeable with a clean ever so subtle note of citrus crispness.

4. **Earnest Shandy – Lemon Lime.** Lemon Lime shandy plus a hint of Strawberry add up to refreshment. Opens with a wonderful citrus aroma, followed by the most pleasant lemon and lime flavors. The addition of strawberry balances out the bitterness of the lemon. Leaving a low 4.5% perfect for all day enjoyment.

5. **Oktoberfest - Traditional German Lager.** Deep orange in color, light malt on the front end and a clean finish describes this lager well.

6. **New Sincerity - West Coast IPA.** West Coast IPAs focus on hops. Citrus and floral hops nose, medium body with a most pleasant taste. Sip after sip, New Sincerity delivers. Bittered with Magnum, whirlpool with Amarillo and Simcoe. Dry hop with Cascade, Centennial and Simcoe.
IBU 64 SRM 7 ABV 6.9% Price Tier 1
7. **O Tannenbaum-Spruce Tip Ale.** Utilizes Fresh spruce tips in the boil as the replacement for some of the hops, normally present for bitterness. The aroma is full of pleasant, not distracting spruce notes, followed by a unique perfectly balanced spruce flavor component. This is the Christmas ale you have been waiting for.
IBU 32 SRM 6 ABV 6.8% Price Tier 2
8. **Holiday Spicewood – American Barleywine style ale** brewed with copious amounts of spices, coriander, allspice, nutmeg and crystalized ginger. Just for an extra kick, pounds, upon pounds of cinnamon sticks and toasted oak chips were added. The nose is full of cinnamon, drinks smooth, with a hint of orange and finishes with a slight oakness.

9. Honeybuzz – Double IPA with honey. Honey forward, comes off as not as hoppy as other DIPA's due to the large amount of locally sourced honey in this beer. Don't be fooled by the smoothness of this DIPA, it will get you buzzing.

10. Phone*Wallet*Keys-Hazy IPA. Beer Pressure was the first Hazy IPA brewed by ebw and since then, many more Haze beers have been developed. Each with it's own hop blend and unique attributes. P*W*K utilized a mix of Citra, El Dorado and Galaxy hops, with noticeable white grapefruit characteristics. When the evening has near it's end, and you have to move on, don't forget Phone*Wallet*Keys

IBU 34 SRM 5 ABV 7.3% Price Tier 2

11. **Raspberry Hefeweizen** - A Hefeweizen is a traditional Bavarian-style wheat beer characterized by its hazy appearance, high carbonation, and distinct banana and clove aroma/flavor, produced by specialized yeast. This beer is unfiltered and adds enjoyment to every pint. Raspberry was added to give the Hefe a little character. Balance out with the yeast.

IBU 12 SRM 4 ABV 4.8% Price Tier 1

12. Crunchy Hippie – Granola Brown Ale. This beer was developed name first, what is a Crunchy Hippie beer? After some thought, the idea of liquid granola was used to come up with the recipe. Brewed with oats, wheat, and actual granola nuggets. Pours a dark brown, with a light body. Enjoy the mellow malt flavor, and slight cherry sweetness on the finish.
