Ask the barkeep about our newest and upcoming beers!

- 1. Cold Break - Cold Pale Ale.** A cold lager strain of yeast was utilized over the warmer fermenting ale yeast. Plus the addition of rice to lighten the body lead to a low/soft bitterness that allows for a “showcase of hop flavor”, without the bitterness. Hops: Azacca, Nectarone, and Rakau.
IBU 36 SRM 4 ABV 5.3% Price Tier 1
- 2. Hoppy Camper – Hazy Pale Ale.** A juicy blend of Citra, Mosaic, and El Dorado hops will take your on an adventure. Hiking in the woods, an evening around a fire, or kicking it with your friends are all better with a Hoppy Camper.
IBU 26 SRM 4 ABV 5.2% Price Tier 1
- 3. Easy – Lager.** Golden yellow color, light body and tastes awesome! Easy lager is special, not just another lager, it a craft lager. Motueka Hops have a natural lively lemon and lime characteristics that are noticeable with a clean ever so subtle note of citrus crispness.

- 4. Kolsch Lager -** a light, crisp German cold-conditioned lager with a smooth, clean finish. It has a pale golden color, subtle fruitiness, and a delicate balance of mild hop bitterness and soft malt sweetness.

- 5. Barrel Aged Bigger Oatis – Triple Oatmeal Stout.** Brewed to be a smoother, stronger and more enjoyable than Big Oatis. This beer is enhanced even further after aging for a year Rye Whiskey American Oak barrel.

- 6. New Sincerity – West Coast IPA.** West Coast IPAs focus on hops. Citrus and floral hops nose, medium body with a most pleasant taste. Sip after sip, New Sincerity delivers.

- 7. Phone*Wallet*Keys-Hazy IPA.** Beer Pressure was the first Hazy IPA brewed by ebw and since then, many more Haze beers have been developed. Each with it's own hop blend and unique attributes. P*W*K utilized a mix of Citra, El Dorado and Galaxy hops, with noticeable white grapefruit characteristics. When the evening has near it's end, and you have to move on, don't forget Phone*Wallet*Keys
IBU 34 SRM 5 ABV 7.3% Price Tier 2
- 8. Pumpkin Bliss – Pumpkin Spiced Lager.** A balanced blend of pumpkin, brown sugar, and spices bring a uniquely seasonal kick to a German-inspired dunkel lager.
IBU 23 SRM 15 ABV 5.8% Price Tier 1
- 9. Honeybuzz – Double IPA with honey.** Honey forward, comes off as not as hoppy as other DIPA's due to the large amount of locally sourced honey in this beer. Don't be fooled by the smoothness of this DIPA, it will get you buzzing.
IBU 88 SRM 10 ABV 9.1% Price Tier 2 Available in 4-packs to go
- 10. Earnest Bock -** The earnest Bock has been reformulated to be more of a German Traditional Dunkles Bock. The flavor was strengthened to better fit the style. Featuring rich bready and toasty flavor from both Munich and Melanoiden malts. After a sip, the smooth, clean finish hits without being cloyingly sweet. Enjoy this strong, dark, and malty German lager by the liter.
IBU 21 SRM 14 ABV 5.9% Price Tier 1 1 liter stein \$13.50

11. Oktoberfest - Traditional German Lager. Deep orange in color, light malt on the front end and a clean finish describes this lager well.

12. Crunchy Hippy – Granola Brown Ale. This beer was developed name first, what is a Crunchy Hippy beer? After some thought, the idea of liquid granola was used to come up with the recipe. Brewed with actual granola, plus oats, wheat and cherries.

IBU 40 SRM 21 ABV 6.2% Price Tier 1

13. Killerney-Irish Red Cream Ale –This is the beer that made the village of Killerney famous. Red in color, strong body and low on hops.

14. Worker's Porter-This porter was designed for smooth enjoyment. A clean fermenting yeast allows the slight roast from the malt to be detected.

15. Earnest American Festbier- The German Festbier, served in Munich during Oktoberfest, was the inspiration for ebw American Festbier lager. Brewed lighter, with less biscuit/cracker/toasted malt tasting notes to better match the American Lager style. Will be on draft at the German American Fest.

IBU 22 SRM 4 ABV 5.4% Price Tier 1

16. Hello Beer - Hibiscus beer. Brewed with hibiscus flowers, sweet orange peel and a touch of coriander. There is subtle hibiscus flowers on the nose, pours a nice pinkish color, with a white head, low bitterness and a pleasant clean finish.

IBU 24 SRM 4 ABV 5.7% Price Tier 1

17. Between the Limes - Tart Lime IPA. Featuring Citra, Mosaic and Motueka hops. The tartness hits, as you sip it mellows until your glass is empty. Read between the limes, this is a great beer.

IBU 40 SRM 4 ABV 7.2% Price Tier 2

18. Strawberry Kiwi Sour - Tart beer. What is better and more refreshing on a hot summer day than the cool and sour taste of strawberries and kiwis. Putting all that brisk taste in one of our amazing sour beers. Other than that, nothing...nothing is better.
